Tournament Fun Facts

1. Where is Vancouver, Washington? *Contrary to what you may think Vancouver, Washington is not located near Canada. In fact we are located at the opposite end of the State, across the Columbia River from Portland, Oregon.*
2. How do we get there? *By car: I-5 is the major artery for the North-South traveler on the west coast and goes directly through our area. By Air: Portland International Airport is 15 minutes from downtown Vancouver, Washington. So as you can see we are not isolated.*
3. How close are we to the World Series Site? *From Vancouver it takes any where from 30 – 45 minutes by car (depending on traffic).*
4. What will the weather be like? *The average temperature for Vancouver in July and August is a high of 80 degrees and a low of 57 degrees. The record temperature for August is 107 degrees, so it can get hot here. Average rainfall for July and August is .97 inches. So, we do not expect much rain.*
5. Has this area ever hosted a Tournament of this magnitude before? *Yes, Washington District Four has hosted five other Regional Tournaments. They where: Junior Baseball and Junior Softball, both at the same time in 2001; and Junior Softball in 2002; and Major Softball in 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007.*
